I am transmitting the following act, which I have signed to become Public Law No. 23-10 with item veto for the reasons stated in this transmittal:

Congressional Act No. 23-03, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND SECTIONS 9 AND 12 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 22-42, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 22-60, 22-80, 22-103 AND 22-141, TO MODIFY THE USE OF CAPITAL AND HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT FUNDING AND CHANGE THE ALLOTTEE OF SUCH FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN TO FUND THE OPERATIONS OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR FISCAL YEAR SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I have no choice but veto the sections 9(4)(d)(i), 9(4)(d)(ii) and 9(4)(d)(v) on the basis of the advice by the Department of Finance and Administration regarding insufficiency of funds. Thank you.

AN ACT

To further amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-60, 22-80, 22-103 and 22-141, to modify the use of Capital and Human Resources Development funding and change the use and allottee of such funds previously appropriated therein to fund the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia for fiscal year September 30, 2022; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 22-80 and 22-141, is hereby further amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
- 5 The sum of \$16,083,505 or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
- 7 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
- 8 ending September 30, 2022, for the following capital
- 9 improvements, development programs, and projects and human
- 10 resources development. Of the total amount of funds
- appropriated herein, \$1,542,202 shall be deemed to come from
- funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant and
- 13 \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come from funds available
- under the Compact Sector Grants. The sum appropriated by
- this section shall be apportioned as follows:

24	Public Laws Nos. 22-103 and 22-141, is hereby further ame	ended to

1	"Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse
2	Dates.
3	(1) <u>General provisions</u> .
4	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
5	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
6	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
7	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
8	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring
9	that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
10	are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and
11	that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums
12	appropriated.
13	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated by
14	this act are as follows:
15	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be
16	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;
17	(b) Section 3 and section 8(12)(w) - the allottee of
18	these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
19	Federated States of Micronesia;
20	(c) Section 4 — the allottee of these funds shall be
21	the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated
22	States of Micronesia;
23	(d) Section 5 — the allottee of these funds shall be
24	the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;
25	(e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these funds

1	shall be the President of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
3	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
4	(i) Sections $8(1)(f)$ and $8(13)(q)$ — the allottee
5	of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on
6	Compact Review and Planning;
7	(ii) Section $8(8)(a)$ - the allottee of these funds
8	shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
9	(iii) Section $8(8)(b)$ — the allottee of these funds
10	shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
11	(iv) Section $8(8)(c)$ - the allottee of these funds
12	shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk, except the for
13	the \$75,000 for the Weno Municipal Police, whom the allottee
14	shall be the President of the Federated States of
15	Micronesia;
16	(v) Section $8(8)(d)$ - the allottee of these funds
17	shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
18	(vi) Section $8(11)$ — the allottee of these funds
19	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
20	of Micronesia;
21	(vii) Section 8(12)(a) - the allottee of these funds
22	shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;
23	(viii) Section 8(12)(d) through (g) - the allottee of
24	these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective
25	State Supreme Court;

1	(ix) Section 8(12)(h) - the allottee of these funds
2	shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
3	Federated States of Micronesia;
4	(x) Section $9(1)$ - the allottee of these funds
5	shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;
6	(xi) Section $9(3)(b)$ - the allottee of these funds
7	shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
8	(xii) Section $9(3)(b)$ - the allottee of these funds
9	shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
10	(xiv) Section $9(3)(c)$ - the allottee of these funds
11	shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
12	(xv) Section $9(3)(d)$ - the allottee of these funds
13	shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;
14	(xvi) Section $9(3)(e)$ - the allottee of these funds
15	shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
16	(xvii) Section 9(11)(b) - the allottee of these funds
17	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
18	of Micronesia; and
19	(xviii) (Section 9(11)(d) - the allottee of these
20	funds shall be the President of the Constitutional
21	Convention;
22	(xix) Section $9(8)(0)$ — the allottee of these funds
23	shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health;
24	(xx) Section $9(4)(d)(iv)$ - the allottee of these
25	funds shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government.

1	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
2	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
3	September 30, 2022; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
4	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse."
5	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7 8	becoming law without such approval.
