#### AN ACT

To further amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-60, 22-80, 22-103, 22-141 and 23-10, to modify the use of Capital and Human Resources Development funding and change the use and allottee of such funds previously appropriated therein to fund the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia for fiscal year September 30, 2022, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 22-80, 22-141 and 23-10, is hereby further amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
- 5 The sum of \$16,083,505 or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
- 7 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
- 8 ending September 30, 2022, for the following capital
- 9 improvements, development programs, and projects and human
- 10 resources development. Of the total amount of funds
- appropriated herein, \$1,542,202 shall be deemed to come from
- 12 funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant and
- 13 \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come from funds available
- under the Compact Sector Grants. The sum appropriated by
- 15 this section shall be apportioned as follows:

9	Section 2. Section 12 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by
10	Public Laws Nos. 22-103, 22-141 and 23-10, is hereby further
11	amended to read as follows:
12	"Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse
13	Dates.
14	(1) General provisions.
15	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
16	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
17	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
18	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
19	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring
20	that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
21	are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and
22	that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums
23	appropriated.
24	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated by
25	this act are as follows:

1	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be
2	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;
3	(b) Section 3 and section 8(12)(w) - the allottee of
4	these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
5	Federated States of Micronesia;
6	(c) Section $4$ — the allottee of these funds shall be
7	the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia;
9	(d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be
10	the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;
11	(e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these funds
12	shall be the President of the Federated States of
13	Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
14	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
15	(i) Sections $8(1)(f)$ and $8(13)(q)$ — the allottee
16	of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on
17	Compact Review and Planning;
18	(ii) Section $8(8)(a)$ — the allottee of these funds
19	shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
20	(iii) Section $8(8)(b)$ - the allottee of these funds
21	shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
22	(iv) Section $8(8)(c)$ — the allottee of these funds
23	shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk, except the for
24	the \$75,000 for the Weno Municipal Police, whom the allottee
25	shall be the President of the Federated States of

1	Micronesia;
2	(v) Section $8(8)(d)$ - the allottee of these funds
3	shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
4	(vi) Section $8(11)$ — the allottee of these funds
5	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
6	of Micronesia;
7	(vii) Section 8(12)(a) - the allottee of these funds
8	shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;
9	(viii) Section 8(12)(d) through (g) - the allottee of
10	these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective
11	State Supreme Court;
12	(ix) Section 8(12)(h) - the allottee of these funds
13	shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
14	Federated States of Micronesia;
15	(x) Section $9(1)$ — the allottee of these funds
16	shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;
17	(xi) Section $9(3)(b)$ - the allottee of these funds
18	shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
19	(xii) Section $9(3)(b)$ - the allottee of these funds
20	shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
21	(xiv) Section $9(3)(c)$ - the allottee of these funds
22	shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
23	(xv) Section $9(3)(d)$ - the allottee of these funds
24	shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;
25	(xvi) Section 9(3)(e) - the allottee of these funds

9	shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health;
10	(xx) Section $9(4)(d)(iv)$ - the allottee of these
11	funds shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government;
12	(xxi) Section $9(4)(j)$ — the allottee of these funds
13	shall be the Governor of Yap State.
14	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
15	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
16	September 30, 2022; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
17	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse."
