## AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187 and 22-188, by amending sections 4 and 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.
