The Honorable Quincy Lawrence, is the Floor Leader of the Twenty Third Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia as seated on May 11, 2023. He is a two-year member from the State of Pohnpei representing Congressional Election District Two (2). Lawrence is the 10th person to take on the role of parliamentarian for the Congress. He is a member of the Committees on: Education, External Affairs, and Transportation and Communication.

Born November 8, 1979, Lawrence is currently the youngest member of Twenty Third Congress and a newcomer to the political arena. Lawrence is a Xavier graduate ('97) and began his tertiary journey at the College of Micronesia and continued to the University of Guam ('04) where he received his Bachelor of Arts in Education before wrapping up at the San Diego State University with a Master's in Education ('08). He brings with him over 10 years of practical experience in the field of Education. His experiences started as a teacher ('04-'09) at the Pohnpei Island Central School where he was instrumental in the school's accreditation by WASC. Lawrence then moved to the National Government to become the Department of Education's Assistant Secretary for the Division of Quality and Effectiveness and was also instrumental in the development and implementation of the FSM School Accreditation System.

In the education community, Lawrence also served as the Micronesia Country Coordinator for the Global Learning and Observation to Benefit the Environment (GLOBE) program

('14) and helped restart the program in FSM schools. He also served as the Country Coordinator for the Pacific Islands Literacy and Numeracy Assessment program. During the Corona Virus Pandemic, Lawrence was a member of the National Task Force and chaired the National Risk Communication and Community Engagement sub-committee.

Lawrence is married to Brigeen Wichep Lawrence and they are blessed with three children: son Ihnan Kavai and two daughters, Akita Brinnette and Oceania.
