## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to article IV of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia by repealing section 9 to permit capital punishment, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Proposed amendment. It is hereby proposed that 2 article IV of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia 3 be amended to read as follows: 4 "ARTICLE IV 5 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS 6 SECTION 1. No law may deny or impair freedom of expression, 7 peaceable assembly, association, or petition. 8 SECTION 2. No law may be passed respecting an establishment 9 of religion or impairing the free exercise of religion, except 10 that assistance may be provided to parochial schools for 11 non-religious purposes. 12 SECTION 3. A person may not be deprived of life, liberty, 13 or property without due process of law, or be denied the equal 14 protection of the laws. 15 SECTION 4. Equal protection of the laws may not be denied 16 or impaired on account of sex, race, ancestry, national origin, 17 language, or social status. 18 SECTION 5. The right of the people to be secure in their 19 persons, houses, papers, and other possessions against unreason-20 able search, seizure, or invasion of privacy may not be violated. 21 A warrant may not issue except on probable cause, supported by

SECTION 6. The defendant in a criminal case has a right to a speedy public trial, to be informed of the nature of the
