## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to article IX, section 8, of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia to provide for 4-year terms for all Members of Congress; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Proposed amendment. It is hereby proposed that
2	article IX, section 8, of the Constitution of the Federated
3	States of Micronesia be amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 8. The Congress consists of one member elected
5	at large from each state on the basis of state
6	equality, and additional members elected from
7	congressional districts in each state apportioned
8	by population. All Mmembers elected of the basis of
9	state eduality serve for a 4-year term/ and all other
10	ሰቃሰኞታቱ ተøተ 1 ሃቃልታል. Each member has one vote, except
11	on the final reading of bills. Congressional
12	elections are held bienhilly quadrennially as provided
13	by statute."
14	Section 2. Procedure. Upon this act becoming law, the proposed
15	constitutional amendment set out in section 1 will become part of
16	the Constitution after completion of procedures and ratification
17	as required by Public Law No. 2-51.
18	Section 3. Effective date. This act shall become law upon
19	approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
20	or upon its becoming law without such approval.
