## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 163, 206, 209, and 210 and to repeal sections 207 and 208  $\,$ of title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia to limit and redefine salary premiums for public service system employees, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 163 of title 52 of the Code of the Federa d States 1 of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 "Section 163. Premiums. To recognize circumstances of mployment which make it appropriate that recognition be given to a hievement 5 of professional standing and to labor market conditions satside the Trust Territory, the following premiums are provided to public 6 service employees. When an employee is receiving a premium in 7 8 addition to his base salary, the sum of his base salary ous premium shall constitute his adjusted base salary for the  $p_{\rm c}$  upose of computing differentials:

- (1) Except as otherwise hereinafter provided, employees who are cities of the Trust Tettitoty shall receive as compensation a base salary as provided in section 205 of this chapter.
