A BILL FOR AN ACT

To establish a salary plan for all employees of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia; to repeal Public Law No. 1-46; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Statement of purpose. It is the declared purpose of the
2 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to freeze the salaries of all
3 employees of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia at
4 their present rates of pay. This salary freeze shall remain in effect until
5 such time as a new Public Service Salary Act and Public Service System Act can
6 be implemented.

7 Section 2. Applicability. This act shall be applicable to all employment
8 positions in the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia now
9 existing or hereafter established.

10 Section 3. Salary plan. Each employee of the National Government of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia is entitled to receive only the salary he or she
12 is receiving on the effective date of this act.

13 Section 4. Existing employment contracts. The provisions of this act
14 shall not impair, change, increase, or decrease the obligations of any
15 existing employment contract to which the National Government of the Federated
16 States of Micronesia is a party to.

17 Section 5. New employees. Subsequent to the effective date of this act
18 all new employees hired by the National Government shall receive rates of pay
19 commensurate with other similarly employed National Government employees,
20 based on such objective factors as educational background, work experience in
21 a related field, and the duties and responsibilities of the position involved.

22 Section 6. Repealer. Public Law No. 1-6 is hereby repealed in its
23 entirety.


24 Section 7. Effective date. This act shall become law upon approval by
25 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
