A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to article IV of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia by repealing section 9 to permit capital punishment, and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:	
7	Section 1. Proposed amendment. It is hereby proposed that	
1	article IV of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia	
2	be amended to read as follows:	
3 4	"ARTICLE IV	
	DECLARATION OF RIGHTS	
5	SECTION 1. No law may deny or impair freedom of	
6	expression, peaceable assembly, association, or petition.	
7	SECTION 2. No law may be passed respecting an	
8	establishment of religion or impairing the free exercise	
9	of religion, except that assistance may be provided to	
10	parochial schools for non-religious purposes.	
11	SECTION 3. A person may not be deprived of life,	
12	liberty, or property without due process of law, or be	
13	denied the equal protection of the laws.	
14	SECTION 4. Equal protection of the laws may not be	
15	denied or impaired on account of sex, race, ancestry,	
16	national origin, language, or social status.	
17	SECTION 5. The right of the people to be secure in	
18	houses papers, and other possessions against	
19	their persons, nouses, papers, and their persons are papers, and their	
20	not be violated. A warrant may not issue except on probable

7,	SECTION 8. Excessive bail may not be required, excessive
8	fines imposed, or cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.
9	The writ of habeas corpus may not be suspended unless required
10	for public safety in cases of rebellion or invasion.

12	SECTION $10/9$. Slavery and involuntary servitude are
13	prohibited except to punish crime.
14	SECTION 11/ 10. A bill of attainder or ex post facto
15	law may not be passed.
16	SECTION 12/ 11. A citizen of the Federated States of
17	Micronesia may travel and migrate within the Federated States.
18	SECTION 13/ 12. Imprisonment for debt is prohibited."
19	Section 2. Procedure and ratification. Upon this act becoming
20	law, the proposed constitutional amendment set out in section 1 will
21	become part of the Constitution after completion of procedures and
22	ratification as required by Public Law No. 2-51.
