A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 2-35, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-42 and 3-5, which appropriated the sum of \$637,600 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Ponape, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Sect	ion 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 2-35, as amended by Public
2	Laws Nos.	2-42 and 3-5, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
