To amend sections 215, 222, and 229 of title 21 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia relating to the Federated States of Micronesia Telecommunications Corporation, and for other purposes.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 215 of title 21 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 215. Board of Directors - Regular meetings. 3 Regular meetings shall be held not less than twice per calendar year, at such times and place or places as shall 5 be determined by the bylaws." Section 2. Section 222 of title 21 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 222. Management. There shall be a chief executive 9 officer of the Corporation, whose compensation, title, and 10 term of office shall be determined by the Board. The chief 11 executive officer shall be responsible for the management 12 of the operations of the Corporation, and shall, in accordance 13 with the policies established by the Board, retain, direct, 14 and terminate the services of employees. Subject to the 15 Board's approval, the chief executive officer shall select and 16 train a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia to take 17 over the responsibilities of the chief executive officer as 18 soon as feasible." 19 Section 3. Section 229 of title 21 of the Code of the Federated 20 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: 21
- "Section 229. Transition Employees. The Corporation shall

1	undertake to employ the employees of the Trust Territory
2	Government and the State governments who are employed in
3	good standing in telecommunications services at the time

7	their former responsibilities, or at the rate of wages
