### AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 3-48 by amending sections 1, 5, 6, and 7 for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$1,384,623 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1985, as supplemental funding for the Department of External Affairs, the Department of Social Services, the Department of Resources and Development, the Department of Finance, the Office of the Public Defender, the Office of the Budget, the Office of Planning and Statistics, the Micronesian Maritime Authority, the Telecommunications Corporation, the Vocational Rehabilitation Services matching grant, the Student Loan Revolving Fund, the Trades, Training and Testing program, the National Plan Task Force, hospital equipment, and the general election; reducing the sum appropriated under the U.S. Grant Special Fund, increasing the employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
