## A RESOLUTION

Requesting Continental Airlines and Air Micronesia to reduce Air Micronesia's fare within the Federated States of Micronesia.

- WHEREAS, in the past, Air Micronesia has used the unpaved
- and poor condition of the airfields in the Federated States of
- Micronesia as one reason for its high fares; and
- WHEREAS, the airfields on Majuro, Kwajalein, Ponape, Truk,
- Guam, and Saipan are now paved, thereby eliminating this excuse for 5
- high fares in these areas of the route; and
- WHEREAS, in the past, Air Micronesia also used the high cost 7
- of fuel as one reason to justify its high fares; and
- WHEREAS, there seems to be a reduction in the cost of fuel,
- but Air Micronesia's fares seem to be continuously on the rise; and
- WHEREAS, many times passengers are bumped because no seats are 17 4
- available on the Air Micronesia flight which proves that Air Micro-
- nesia is making money in the Federated States of Micronesia; now,
- therefore, 14
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of 15
- .16 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that Continental Airlines,
- and Air Micronesia in particular, be requested to reduce its fares 17
- 18 in the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution 19
- be transmitted to the president of Continental Airlines, the president 20
- of Air Micronesia, the general manager of Air Micronesia, and the
- Air Micronesia managers in the States of Ponape, Truk, and Yap.
