## A RESOLUTION

Requesting an assessment study of the impact of United States Federal programs in health in the Federated States of Micronesia.

- WHEREAS, the United States has provided funding for health care
- 2 in the Federated States of Micronesia under many different programs;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, responsibility for health care will be assumed by the
- 5 State and National Governments under the proposed Compact of Free
- 6 Association; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a review and assessment of the impact and effectiveness
- 8 of United States health programs in Micronesia will provide needed
- 9 baseline data and insights into effective methods for the delivery
- 10 of health services in the Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore,
- 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
- 12 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress requests an
- 13 assessment study of the impact of United States Federal programs in
- 14 health be undertaken in the Federated States of Micronesia as soon as
- 15 possible; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
- 17 be transmitted to United States Senator Daniel Inouye; the Governors
- 18 of the States of Kosrae, Ponape, Truk, and Yap; the Chief of the Division
- 19 of Health Services, Federated States of Micronesia; and the President
- 20 of the Federated States of Micronesia.
