## A RESOLUTION

Directing the Banking Board and the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia to investigate the activities of the banks operating within the Federated States of Micronesia to determine whether they comply with the intent, the goals, and the objectives of the Federated States of Micronesia.

- WHEREAS, section 201 of title 29 of the Code of the Federated 1
- States of Micronesia created the Banking Board, hereinafter referred
- to as the Board, and that same title vests in and imposes upon the
- Board certain powers and duties; and
- WHEREAS, section 504 imposes upon the Board the duty to deter-5
- mine whether a bank applying for renewal of its license has "served
- the needs of its community"; and 7
- WHEREAS, said section 504 explains that "to serve the needs of
- its community" means, among other things, that such bank has used its
- best efforts to promote the citizens and residents of the Federated 10
- States of Micronesia to executive positions in the bank; that the 11
- loans made by such bank in the Federated States of Micronesia bear 12
- a reasonable relationship to such bank's deposits in the Federated
- States of Micronesia; and that such bank has abstained from any unfair 14
- discrimination among its customers and the people its serves; and 15
- WHEREAS, the expressly stated goals of the Federated States of 16
- Micronesia are that the executive positions in all banks operating 17
- within the Federated States of Micronesia shall be occupied by 18
- citizens and residents of the Federated States of Micronesia; that 19
- at least 75 percent of the total deposits taken by a bank in the 20
- Federated States of Micronesia should be loaned to citizens and
- residents of and business entities located in the Federated States 22
- of Micronesia; and that no bank should discriminate unfairly among 23
- its customers and the people it serves; and 24
- WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Congress of the Federated States 25

1 of Micronesia to increase the usury limit, pursuant to Public Law

- 2 No. 2-33, to enable the banks to generate more money to be made
- 3 available to the citizens and residents of the Federated States of
- 4 Micronesia who are interested in applying for loans; now, therefore,
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States
- 6 of Micronesia, First Special Session, 1983, that the Congress directs
- 7 the Banking Board and the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
- 8 Micronesia to investigate the activities of the banks operating
- 9 within the Federated States of Micronesia to determine whether they
- 10 comply with the intent, the goals, and the objectives of the Federated
- 11 States of Micronesia; and
- 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Banking Board and the Public
- 13 Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia be further directed to
- 14 submit the reports of their findings to the Congress of the Federated
- 15 States of Micronesia during the Second Regular Session of the Third
- 16 Congress; and
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
- 18 be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, to
- 19 the Chairman of the Banking Board, to the Public Auditor of the Federated
- 20 States of Micronesia, and to the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
- 21 States of Micronesia.
