

A RESOLUTION

Expressing the support of the Third Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1983, for the confirmation of the nomination of Mr. Richard Montoya to be Assistant Secretary of Territorial and International Affairs within the United States Department of the Interior.

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Richard Montoya has been nominated for the position of
2 Assistant Secretary of Territorial and International Affairs within the
3 United States Department of the Interior; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Richard Montoya recently traveled to the Federated States
5 of Micronesia and met with the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
6 and officials of the executive and legislative branches of the Federated
7 States of Micronesia National Government; and

8 WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Third Congress of the Federated States
9 of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1983, that Mr. Richard Montoya is a
10 good choice for the position to which he has been nominated, as indicated by
11 his openness and his expressions of concern for the many problems of the
12 Pacific region and the Federated States of Micronesia in particular; now,
13 therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia,
15 Second Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress hereby expresses its support
16 for the confirmation of the nomination of Mr. Richard Montoya to be Assistant
17 Secretary of Territorial and International Affairs within the United States
18 Department of the Interior; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Subcommittee on Interior of the United
20 States Senate Committee on Appropriations be respectfully requested to
21 expedite the hearings on Mr. Montoya's nomination; and
