A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 2 and 3 of Public Law No. 4-28, Truk State public projects, for the purpose of reapportioning funds and designating an additional allottee, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

15 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 4-28 is hereby amended
16 to read as follows:
17 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
19 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
20 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of
21 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(i) of section 2
22 shall be the Truk Lagoon radio association. The allottee
23 of funds appropriated under subsection (1)(j) ~~and sub~~
24 ~~section (9)(d)~~ of section 2 shall be the chairman of the
25 Truk congressional delegation. The allottee of funds

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1 appropriated under subsections (9)(b)(xxi), (9)(b)(xxii),
2 (9)(c)(i)b) through o), (9)(c)(ii) and (9)(d) of section 2 shall
3 be the Governor of Truk State. The other allottees shall be
4 the development authorities for the respective areas of Truk
5 State. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that
6 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
7 used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that
8 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appro-
9 priated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
10 appropriated by this act shall remain effective until funds
11 are fully expended. The allottees shall make a written
12 report of the status of the funds appropriated hereunder
13 to the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
14 during its October regular session each year until such
15 time as all funds are fully expended."

16 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
17 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
18 becoming law without such approval.
