## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to article IX, sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia to permit States to levy income and business taxes and to eliminate the constitutional requirement for the division of National income and business taxes and to further amend title 54 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-32, by amending sections 121 and 141 to reduce income and business taxes by fifty percent upon the ratification of the proposed constitutional amendments, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. It is hereby proposed that article IX, section 2,
2	of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia be amended
3	to read as follows:
4	"Section 2. The following powers are expressly delegated
5	to Congress:
6	(a) to provide for the national defense;
7	(b) to ratify treaties;
8	(c) to regulate immigration, emigration,
9	naturalization, and citizenship;
10	(d) to impose taxes, duties, and tariffs based
11	on imports;
12	led to impose taxes on incomes
13	( $f_{\underline{e}}$ ) to issue and regulate currency;
14	(gf) to regulate banking, foreign and interstate
15	commerce, insurance, the issuance and use of commercial
16	paper and securities, bankruptcy and insolvency, and
17	patents and copyrights;
18	( $n_{\underline{g}}$ ) to regulate navigation and shipping except
19	within lagoons, lakes, and rivers;
20	(ih) to establish usury limits on major loans;
21	(ji) to provide for a national postal system;
22	$(k_{\underline{j}})$ to acquire and govern new territory;
23	$(1_{\underline{k}})$ to govern the area set aside as the national
24	capital;
25	$(n_1)$ to regulate the ownership, exploration, and

1	exploitation of natural resources within the marine space
2	of the Federated States of Micronesia beyond 12 miles from
3	island baselines;
4	(🏧) to establish and regulate a national public
5	service system;
6	$(\phi_{\underline{n}})$ to impeach and remove the President, Vice-
7	President, and justices of the Supreme Court;
8	$(p_{\underline{o}})$ to define major crimes and prescribe
9	penalties, having due regard for local custom and
10	tradition; and
11	$(q_{\underline{p}})$ to override a Presidential veto by not less
12	than a 3/4 vote of all the state delegations, each delega-
13	tion casting one vote."
14	Section 2. It is hereby proposed that article IX, section 3, of
15	the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia be amended
16	to read as follows:
17	"Section 3. The following powers may be exercised con-
18	currently by Congress and the states:
19	(a) to appropriate public funds;
20	(b) to borrow money on the public credit;
21	(c) to promote education and health; and
22	(d) to establish systems of social security and
23	public welfare/: and
24	(e) to impose taxes on income."
25	Section 3. It is hereby proposed that article IX, section 5, of

1	the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia be amended
2	to read as follows:
3	"Section 5. National taxes shall be imposed uniformly.
4	Not less than 50% of the revenues from taxes, duties, and
5	tariffs based on imports shall be paid into the treasury
6	of the state where collected."
7	Section 4. Section 121 of title 54 of the Code of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
9	"Section 121. Tax on wages and salaries. There shall be
10	assessed, levied, collected, and paid a tax of #1x three
11	percent upon the first \$11,000 and ten five percent upon
12	the amount over the first \$11,000 of all wages and salaries
13	received by every employee, as defined, except as provided
14	in section 122 of this chapter."
15	Section 5. Section 141 of title 54 of the Code of the Federated
16	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 141. Tax on gross revenues: Exemption.
18	(1) Thete shall be assessed levied tollected and
19	paid a tax of \$80 pet year upon that pottion of the
20	amount of stoss tevenues estated by every business subject
21	to the ptovisions of this enaptet which does not exceed
22	\$106000 pet peat!
23	(2) There shall be assessed, levied, collected, and
24	paid a tax of three one and one-half percent per year upon
25	that portion of the amount of gross revenues earned by every

8	Section 6. Upon this act becoming law, the proposed constitu-
9	tional amendment set out in section 1 of this act will become part of
0.	the Constitution after completion of procedures and ratification as
1	required by Public Law No. 2-51, as amended by Public Law No. 2-58.
2	Section 7. Sections 1, 2, 3 and 6 of this act shall become
.3	law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of
4	Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval. Sections
.5	4 and 5 of this act shall become law on the first day of the first
.6	fiscal year following the ratification of the amendments to the
.7	Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia set forth in
8	section 1 of this act.
