AN ACT

To amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia by adding a new chapter 2 for the purpose of authorizing the President to issue passports, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micro-
