FOURTH REGULAR SESSION, 1986

CONGRESSIONAL BILL No. 4-362, C.D.1,
C.D.2, C.D.3

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$1,200,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the purpose of funding public projects in Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
4 1987, for the purpose of funding public projects in Pohnpei State.

5 Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this act
6 shall be apportioned as follows:

24 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
25 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of

1 1979. The allottee shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State for all the
2 appropriations herein, except that the Pohnpei Community Action Agency
3 shall be the allottee for appropriations under subsection (2) of section
4 2, the Menin Keder Lapalap of the Madolenihmw Municipal Government
5 shall be the allottee for appropriations under subsection (1)(a) of
6 section 2, the Luhken Menlap of the Kitti Municipal Government shall be
7 the allottee for appropriations under subsection (1)(b) of section 2,
8 the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs shall be the allottee for appropriations
9 under subsection (3)(a) of section 2, the Kolonia Town Mayor shall be
10 the allottee for appropriations under subsection (3)(b) of section 2,
11 the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuahfik shall be the allottee for all appro-
12 priations under subsection (3)(c) of section 2, and the Pohnpei Farmers
13 Home Administration Office shall be the allottee for appropriations
14 under subsections (1)(a)(xxix), (1)(b)(xxviii), and (4)(f) of section 2.
15 The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so
16 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes
17 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
18 of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate
19 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1987.


