A RESOLUTION

Requesting that the President of the Federated States of Micronesia join the Congress in the creation of a Task Force on Reduction of Task Forces to study means to reduce the number of task forces in the Federated States of Micronesia.

- 1 WHEREAS, there has been an unjustifiable and drastic increase in
- 2 the number of government-related task forces in the Federated
- 3 States of Micronesia; and
- WHEREAS, these task forces tend to duplicate, hinder, and/or
- 5 usurp the functions of legitimate governmental entities while
- 6 draining the public treasury; and
- WHEREAS, this has resulted in a trend away from government
- 8 by the constitutionally-created branches of government and
- 9 towards undemocratic government by task force; and
- 10 WHEREAS, democracy, political stability, and constitutional
- 11 government in the Federated States of Micronesia could best be
- 12 preserved by taking prompt action to reduce the number of govern-
- 13 ment-related task forces; now, therefore,
- 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Fourth Congress of the Federated States
- 15 of Micronesia, Third Special Session, 1986, that the Congress hereby
- 16 respectfully requests that the President of the Federated States
- 17 of Micronesia join the Congress in the creation of a Task Force on
- 18 Reduction of Task Forces to study means to reduce the number of
- 19 task forces in the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
- 21 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
- 22 of Micronesia and the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
- 23 States of Micronesia.
