A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28, Truk State public projects, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64, and 4-67, by amending subsection (8)(r) to change the purpose for which funds were appropriated, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64 and 4-67, is hereby further amended  
3 to read as follows:
