A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress to hold in abeyance the proposed Federated States of Micronesia Classification Plan submitted by the Office of Personnel.

1 WHEREAS, the National Government of the Federated States of Micro-
2 nesia needs an employee classification scheme which is equitable and
3 uniform for all three branches of the Government; and

4 WHEREAS, Congress appreciates the expensive and intense efforts
5 expended by the Office of Personnel in devising and formulating the
6 Federated States of Micronesia Classification Plan; and

7 WHEREAS, the Personnel Officer of the Federated States of Micronesia
8 has recently transmitted a copy of the proposed Federated States of
9 Micronesia Classification Plan to the Speaker of the Congress; and

10 WHEREAS, the proposed plan is a lengthy document which would
11 apparently require extensive and careful congressional review; and

12 WHEREAS, while the Personnel Officer of the Federated States of
13 Micronesia has recommended adoption of the plan to the Speaker of the
14 Congress, the Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations is
15 now actively considering an employees' salary and classification scheme
16 which, if enacted into law, may well make the adoption of the proposed
17 Federated States of Micronesia Classification Plan unnecessary; and

18 WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations
19 has taken into consideration, and is carefully weighing, the modifications
20 to the employees' classification scheme suggested by the Personnel
21 Officer; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Second Congress of the Federated States
23 of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1982, that it is the sense of
24 the Congress that the proposed Federated States of Micronesia Classi-
25 fication Plan prepared by the Office of Personnel shall not be adopted

1 nor implemented; and

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the sense of the Congress
3 that the Federated States' of Micronesia Classification Plan be held
4 in abeyance pending enactment of legislation establishing an alternative
5 employees' classification scheme; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
7 be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
8 and the Personnel Officer of the Federated States of Micronesia.
