A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to explore the possibility of engaging a multidiscipline consulting firm to provide technical assistance in the National planning and development process.

1 WHEREAS, National development planning is desirable, particularly
2 for an emerging Nation such as the Federated States of Micronesia; and

3 WHEREAS, effective development planning requires a variety of
4 skilled technical personnel including planners, engineers, architects,
5 designers, and project managers; and

6 WHEREAS, the expense to the National Government which would
7 result from hiring the desired skilled technical personnel on an
8 individual contract basis, with resulting salary, transportation,
9 housing, and other benefits, would be prohibitive; and

10 WHEREAS, there exist multidiscipline consulting firms in New
11 Zealand and other countries, with work experience in emerging nations,
12 which may be able to provide high quality technical advice to the
13 Federated States of Micronesia Government at a cost which is lower
14 than that resulting from engaging technical consultants on an
15 individual contract basis; and

16 WHEREAS, all the Governments of the Federated States of
17 Micronesia, as well as the private sector, could benefit from easy
18 access to one or more such technical consulting firms; now, therefore,


19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Second Congress of the Federated States
20 of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1982, that the President
21 of the Federated States of Micronesia is respectfully requested to
22 direct the Secretary of Resources and Development and the Office
23 of Planning and Statistics to conduct a summary of no less than
24 six multidisciplined technical consulting firms with work experience
25 in emerging nations and to encourage no less than three such firms

1 to submit proposals regarding the provision of technical services
2 necessary and desirable to the National planning and development
3 process, which proposals might include the establishment of a
4 branch office in the Federated States of Micronesia; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
6 be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of
7 Micronesia, the Federated States of Micronesia Secretary of
8 Resources and Development, the Federated States of Micronesia
9 National Planner, the Governors of the States of the Federated
10 States of Micronesia, the Speakers of the legislatures of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia, the directors of the resources
12 and development departments of the States in the Federated States
13 of Micronesia, and Gillman Partners of Hamiltons, New Zealand.
