## A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia that eligibility for United States post-secondary education financial assistance programs should be maintained for all students from the Federated States of Micronesia throughout the period of free association with the United States of America.

- 1 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 223 of the Compact of Free Associa-
- 2 tion, only those Federated States of Micronesia students who were
- 3 enrolled in colleges and universities on November 2, 1986, remain
- 4 eligible to receive United States post-secondary education financial
- 5 assistance; and
- 6 WHEREAS, numerous problems have been experienced in properly
- 7 implementing this section of the Compact, resulting in many students
- 8 who should rightfully be eligible being denied said assistance; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it has, moreover, become increasingly evident that the
- 10 funds for post-secondary education financial assistance provided
- 11 to the Federated States of Micronesia by the United States under
- 12 section 216(a)(3) of the Compact are woefully inadequate to meet
- 13 the needs of the citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia to
- 14 attend colleges and universities at home and abroad in order to
- 15 obtain essential skills and knowledge vital to the development of the
- 16 Nation; and
- 17 WHEREAS, as a result of this situation the social and economic
- 18 development of the Federated States of Micronesia will be greatly
- 19 imperiled, if not defeated; and
- 20 WHEREAS, it is consequently extremely urgent that steps be
- 21 taken to restore full eligibility for all United States post-
- 22 secondary education financial assistance programs to students from
- 23 the Federated States of Micronesia throughout the period of free
- 24 association with the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS, such assistance includes Pell grants, SEOG, college

1 work study, guaranteed student loans and Perkins loans; now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1987, that the Congress hereby expresses its sense that eligibility for United States postsecondary education financial assistance programs should be maintained 6 for all students from the Federated States of Micronesia throughout the period of free association with the United States of America; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, the Chairman of the Commission on Future Political Status and Transition, the Director of the Office of Freely Associated State Affairs, 11 the Chairman and ranking minority member of the United States House 12 of Representatives Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs, and the Chairman and ranking minority member of the United States Senate 14 Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. 15 Date: 12587 Introduced by: Cun !
