A RESOLUTION

Thanking the Hawaii State Legislature for providing invaluable in-service training opportunities to staff from the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, and expressing the hope of the Congress that such opportunities will be available in the future.

1           WHEREAS, the Presiding Officers, Members and staff of the Hawaii  
2 State Legislature have graciously provided in-service training  
3 opportunities to staff from the Congress of the Federated States  
4 of Micronesia during past years; and

5           WHEREAS, such training opportunities were most recently  
6 provided in April, 1987, when the Chief Clerk of the Congress,  
7 the Assistant Chief Clerk of the Congress, the Assistant  
8 Director of Administration, and the Speaker's Secretary were  
9 all able to work with counterparts in the Hawaii State  
10 Legislature, thereby deriving invaluable insight and  
11 understanding about the workings of the legislative branch  
12 of government; and

13           WHEREAS, through such experiences, the staff of the  
14 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia are better  
15 able to carry out their important duties in an efficient,  
16 professional manner; and

17           WHEREAS, the Congress is extremely appreciative of the  
18 willingness of the Hawaii State Legislature to provide  
19 such assistance to counterparts from the Pacific region, and  
20 hopes that opportunities for such assistance will remain  
21 available in future years; now, therefore,

22           BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifth Congress of the Federated States  
23 of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1987, that the Congress  
24 hereby thanks the Hawaii State Legislature for providing  
25 invaluable in-service training opportunities to staff from


