A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$400,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, for the purpose of funding the activities of the Community Action Agencies in each of the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei, Truk and Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be
- 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
- 4 1990, for the purpose of funding the activities of the Community
- 5 Action Agencies in each of the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei, Truk and Yap.
- 6 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
- 7 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
- 8 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
- 9 1979. The allottees for the funds appropriated under section 1 of
- 10 this act shall be the executive directors of the four State Community
- 11 Action Agencies, who shall each be responsible for ensuring that these
- 12 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
- 13 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
- 14 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated; PROVIDED, however, that no
- 15 funds shall be transferred from the General Fund to any Community
- 16 Action Agency until the executive directors have submitted to the
- 17 Secretary of Finance a copy of their written agreement regarding the
- 18 distribution of funds among the four agencies. The authority of the
- 19 allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
- 20 of September 30, 1990.
