A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$22,958,908 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, judicial branch, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1990; to establish a budget for Compact sections 215(a)(2), 216(a)(1), 216(a)(2), 216(3), and 221(b) and to appropriate special funds available therefore under the Compact; to establish a development budget and to appropriate special funds available therefore under the Compact; to establish employment ceilings; and for therefore under the Compact; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGIESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The
2	sum of \$10,231,425, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
3	appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
4	Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, for the
5	operations of the executive branch of the National Government of the
6	Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1990. Pursuant to
7	Public Law No. 5-119 the Congress of the Federated States of
8	Micronesia hereby declares that the funding appropriated by this
9	section is deemed to be es ential. The sum appropriated by this

All 2 funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, 3 and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not 4 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979, as amended. Each 5 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used soley for the purposes specified in 7 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1990; PROVIDED, however, that the authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by sections 6, 9, 10 and 13 shall not lapse. 12 Section 17.
