1.2	"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
13	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
14	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
15	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of

17	the Governor of the State of Kosrae; except, however, that

7	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
8	The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
9	appropriated by this act shall not lapse until expended."
10	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
12	law without such approval.
