A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 6-10 by amending sections 1, 5 and 12 for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$2,045,146 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, agencies of the National Government and other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds; by amending section 14 for the purpose of modifying employment ceilings; by amending section 15 for the purpose of modifying the authority to reprogram funds; by amending section 16 for the purpose of modifying lapse dates; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

24	of 1979, as amended; PROVIDED, however, that the allottee of the
25	funds appropriated under subparagraphs $(\not\in \underline{d})$ and $(\not\in \underline{e})$ of

subsection (1) of section 1 of this act shall be the President 1 and such authority may not be delegated; PROVIDED FURTHER, that 2 the allottees for funds appropriated under subparagraph (m) of 3 subsection (2) of section 12 of this act shall be the Governors 4 of the respective States and that those funds shall not be 5 disbursed from the General Fund to the allottee unless the 6 President certifies that the State involved has entered into a joint law enforcement agreement for the period of October 1, 8 1989 to September 30, 1990, with the National Government 9 pursuant to chapter 12 of title 12 of the Code of the Federated 10 States of Micronesia. Each allottee shall be responsible for 11 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be 12 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this 13 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 14 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds 15 appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1990; 16 PROVIDED, however, that the authority of the allottees to 17 obligate funds appropriated by sections 6, 9, 10, 12(2)(p), 18 12(2)(q) and 13 shall not lapse." 19 Section 7.
