A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by further amending section 301, as amended by Public Law No. 6-11, to provide that no representative of any State fishing authority, or any subsidiary or affiliate thereof shall serve as a member of the Board of Directors of the NFC and that a representative of each State shall be appointed by the President upon written agreement of both the Governor and Congressional Delegation of that State, and for other purposes.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 301 of title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 6-11, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 301. Micronesian Maritime Authority - Established. 4 5 (1) There is established a Micronesian Maritime Authority composed of five members appointed as follows: 6 7 (a) One representative of each State appointed by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, 11 8 tonsultation with upon written agreement of both the 9 10

 - (b) One at-large member appointed by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia.
 - (2) All appointments shall be for a term of two years. The term of office of each original member shall commence effective the date of the first meeting of the Authority after the effective date of this act. Upon the expiration of the term of an appointed member, his rights and powers of membership shall lapse and the executive director shall declare the vacancy and notify the President
