## A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the Government of Palau and the Government of the United States of America to proceed with all deliberate speed toward completing the process of Palau's self-determination as intended under the trusteeship system.

- 1 WHEREAS, all the political subdivisions of the Trust Territory of
- 2 the Pacific Islands except Palau have attained their current
- 3 political status through the process of self-determination; and
- WHEREAS, the people of the Federated States of Micronesia have
- 5 great respect and understanding for the people of Palau; and
- 6 WHEREAS, articles 1, 55 and 73 of the Charter of the United
- 7 Nations declare as a beneficial goal the self-determination of all
- 8 peoples; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it is in the interest of all the island nations of the
- 10 Pacific and the other nations of the world that the last vestige of
- 11 colonialism, no matter how well meaning or how well intentioned, be
- 12 eradicated; now, therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixth Congress of the Federated States of
- 14 Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1990, that the Government of
- 15 Palau and the Government of the United States of America are
- 16 respectively requested to proceed with all due deliberate speed to
- 17 remove the remaining barriers to the process of achieving political
- 18 self-determination for the people of Palau; and
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
- 20 be transmitted to the Government of Palau, the Government of the
- 21 United States of America and the President of the Federated States
- 22 of Micronesia.
