
A RESOLUTION

Expressing sincere appreciation and gratitude to the Honorable Aloysius Joachim Tuuth, Secretary of Finance, for his many years of devoted and selfless service to the Federated States of Micronesia and for his concern regarding the well-being of the Nation, and wishing him all possible success as he begins law school.

1 WHEREAS, the Honorable Aloysius J. Tuuth has had a most
2 distinguished career in public service, working as a classroom teacher
3 at Yap Intermediate School and at the Outer Islands High School from
4 1965 to 1968, and later at Marianas High School in Saipan from 1970
5 to 1971; and

6 WHEREAS, the Honorable Aloysius J. Tuuth has also served in the
7 Administration of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, working
8 in the Headquarters Personnel Department, and the Headquarters
9 Education Department; and

10 WHEREAS, from 1973 to 1978, the Honorable Aloysius J. Tuuth
11 worked as a Budget Analyst for the District Administration in his
12 home State of Yap, and subsequently with the Program, Planning and
13 Budget Office for the State of Yap; and

14 WHEREAS, in 1979, the Honorable Aloysius J. Tuuth brought his
15 extensive experience in budget, planning, and finance to the Federated
16 States of Micronesia, as Secretary of Finance in the first and
17 second administrations of the National Government of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia; and

19 WHEREAS, the Honorable Aloysius J. Tuuth continues to serve as
20 the Secretary of Finance under the administration of President John R.
21 Hagielgam, in which capacity he has performed above and beyond the
22 call of duty in organizing and managing one of the largest and most
23 diverse departments in the National Government; and

24 WHEREAS, from the organization of the National accounting system
25 to leading the Nation through the issuance of Pacific-Territory Notes,

1 Secretary Tuuth has taken his responsibilities seriously and, in
2 executing them, has demonstrated conscientiousness, determination
3 and dedication to the cause of improving the future of the people of
4 the Federated States of Micronesia; and

5 WHEREAS, to the loss of the Nation, Secretary Tuuth has decided
6 to leave public service and pursue a new career as a lawyer, departing
7 the Federated States of Micronesia for law school this summer; now,
8 therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixth Congress of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1989, that the Congress hereby
11 expresses its heartfelt appreciation and gratitude to the Honorable
12 Aloysius J. Tuuth, and thanks him for his many years of devoted and
13 selfless service to the Federated States of Micronesia, and for his
14 concern regarding the well-being of the Nation; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Congress wishes Secretary Tuuth
16 luck and all possible success as he leaves Government service to
17 begin law school; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
19 be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
20 and the Honorable Aloysius J. Tuuth.
