AN ACT

To increase the tax enforcement authority of the Department of Finance by further amending title 54 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-65, 5-81 and 5-84, to add a new section 157 to subchapter V of chapter 1 to authorize the Secretary of Finance to issue summons in connection with enforcement of the tax laws; to add a new section 205 of chapter 2 regarding inspection of cargo and other imports by customs officials; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Title 54 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 2 Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 157 to

- 4 "Section 157. <u>Summons</u>.
- (1) For the purposes described under sections 151 and
 804 of this title, the Secretary shall be authorized to
 summon the person or persons liable for tax under this
 title to appear before the Secretary or his designee and at
 such appearance to produce such documents and to give such
 testimony as specified in the summons.
 - (2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall also apply to any officer or employee or agent of such person or persons described in subsection (1) of this section, or any third party having possession, custody, or care of books of accounts relating to the business of the person or persons liable for tax under this title."
- 17 Section 2. Title 54 of the Code of the Federated States of 18 Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 205 to

- 20 "Section 205. Inspection of cargo and other imports.
- 21 (1) Shipments of cargo and other imports arriving in 22 the Federated States of Micronesia by seagoing vessel,

aircraft or through the postal system may be subjected to
physical inspection for the purpose of enforcing the
provisions of section 201 of this chapter. Shipments
include, but are not limited to, containers, packages,
baggage, luggage and parcels contained in other forms of
packaging.
(2) Consignees of CY-CY container shipments or
similar shipments which are delivered to a final

- similar shipments which are delivered to a final destination other than the dock shall notify the Division of Customs of the delivery of the shipment and shall not open the shipment without the approval of an official of the Division of Customs. Division of Customs officials shall be granted access to any CY-CY shipments or similar shipments at the importer's premises for purposes of this subsection.
- (3) Officials of the Division of Customs of the Department of Finance may perform physical checks of all containerized items against the invoice provided by the importer."
