## A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to undertake a total review of the organization and operations of the executive branch of the National Government and to make a report and recommendations for structural reorganization with the idea of reducing the bureaucracy, size, operational costs, and increasing the efficiency of the executive branch of the National Government.

- WHEREAS, a new administration has taken office and is currently
- setting up its organization and operations of the executive branch of

- WHEREAS, the start of this new administration presents an 4
- opportune time to review and evaluate the current organizational
- structure and operations of the executive branch of the National
- Government; and
- 8 WHEREAS, there has been growing concern that the National
- Government is too large, involves unnecessary duplication of effort,
- and may be carrying out functions which can be more efficiently
- handled by the States, thereby increasing unnecessary paper work
- and red tape; and
- WHEREAS, the Nation faces step-downs in funding under the 13
- Compact of Free Association and reductions in other revenue sources 14
- for the Nation; and 15
- WHEREAS, there is a desire by the Congress to work with the new 16
- 17 administration in a cooperative effort to evaluate the current
- organization and operations of the National Government so that costs
- can be reduced and efficiency increased; now, therefore, 19
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Congress of the Federated 20
- 21 States of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1991, that the Congress
- 22 hereby respectfully requests the President of the Federated States of
- Micronesia to undertake a total review of the organization and
- 24 operations of the National Government and to make a report and
- 25 recommendations for structural reorganization with the idea of

8 Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia, the Governors of the four States of the Federated States
10 of Micronesia, the Speakers of the four State legislatures of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia, the President of the Senate of the
12 Chuuk State Legislature, the Chief Justices of the State courts of
13 the Federated States of Micronesia, and the Chief Executive Officers
14 of the municipalities of the States of the Federated States of
15 Micronesia.
