A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 2-34, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79, 5-11, 6-106 and 8-10, to modify the use of funds previously appropriated therein for certain public projects in the Mortlocks, Chuuk State, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-17, 4-15, 5-26, 6-106, 7-12 and 8-12, for the purpose of changing the allottee of funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 2-34, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79, 5-11, 6-106, and 8-10,
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:
4 "Section 1. The sum of \$846,200, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
7 ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding certain
8 public projects in the State of Tylik Chuuk. The sum
9 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as

1 Public Laws Nos. 3-17, 4-15, 5-26, 6-106, 7-12 and 8-12, is hereby
2 further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. The allottees for all public projects in the
4 State of T&M Chuuk shall be the development authorities for
5 the respective areas of the State of T&M Chuuk; PROVIDED,
6 however, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under
7 subsection (2) of section 1 of this act shall be the Faichuk
8 PWP Development Authority, and that the allottee of the funds
9 appropriated under subsection (4) of section 1 of this act
10 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State, and that the allottee
11 of the funds appropriated under subsection (5) of section 1
12 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development
13 Authority."

14 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
15 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
16 law without such approval.
