

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 8-19 by amending section 2 for the purpose of modifying funds previously appropriated therein for the Mortlocks in Chuuk State, by amending section 3 for the purpose of changing the allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-19 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this act shall be apportioned as follows:

12          Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-19 is hereby amended  
13 to read as follows:

14               "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
15 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
16 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited  
17 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of  
18 the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section  
19 2 of this act shall be the PWP Development Authority. The  
20 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(b)  
21 of section 2 of this act shall be the Secretary of  
22 Education of the Federated States of Micronesia. The  
23 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(c)  
24 of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks  
25 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated

1           under subsection (1)(e) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
2           Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
3           appropriated under subsection (1)(f) of section 2 of this act  
4           shall be the Saramen Chuuk Academy Board of Directors. The  
5           allottee of all other funds appropriated under section 2 of  
6           this act shall be the President or the President's designee,  
7           except that for Pohnpei State funds to be disbursed to  
8           Nett, U, Mwoakilloa and Pingelap, the allottee shall be  
9           the Pohnpei Community Action Agency, and funds to be  
10          disbursed to Madolenihmw and Kitti, the allottees for  
11          which shall be the respective chief magistrates; PROVIDED,  
12          the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (3)  
13          of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the State  
14          of Yap. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring  
15          that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
16          are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and  
17          that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
18          appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate  
19          funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September  
20          30, 1995."

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1       Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
3 law without such approval.
