To further amend Public Law No. 4-17, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-47, 4-60, 7-62, and 8-31, Kosrae State public projects, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Law No. 8-31, to modify the allottee of certain funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section I. Section 3 of Public Law No. 4-17, as amended by Public Law No. 8-31, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottees for appropriations under subsections (1), (2), (3), and (4) 7 of section 2 shall be the Mayors of Lelu, Tafunsak, Malem, 8 and Utwe Municipalities, respectively. The allottee for 9 appropriations under subsections (5)(a), (c), (d), (e), 10 (f), (f), (h), and (j) of section 2 shall be the Governor 11 of Kosrae State. The allottee for the funds appropriated 12 under subsection (5)(g) of section 2 shall be the Mayor of 13 14 Lelu. The allottee for the appropriation under subsection 1.5 (5)(b) of section 2 shall be the chairman of the Kosrae congressional delegation. The allottee for the appropriation 16 under paragraph (5)(i) of section 2 shall be the chairman of 17 the Kosrae State Commission on Improvement Projects. The 18 19 allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these 20 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall remain in effect until all funds appropriated by this act are fully expended."
