A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 8-18 by amending section 2 for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$40,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, as supplemental funding for the legislative branch, and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-18 is hereby amended
2	to read as follows:
3	"Section 2. Operating expenses of the legislative branch.
4	The sum of \$2/425/900 $2,475,900$, or so much thereof as may
5	be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
6	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
7	ending September 30, 1994, for the operations of the
8	legislative branch of the National Government of the
9	Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1994.
