CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 8-356, C.D.1, C.D.2,
C.D.3, C.D.4

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 8-96 by amending sections 1, 11, and 13 to appropriate the sum of \$1,363,503 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions and refunds, and the development budget; to amend section 14 to raise the employment ceiling, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-96 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The sum of
4 \$14,927,499, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
5 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, for the
7 operations of the executive branch of the National Government of the
8 Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1995. Of the total
9 funds appropriated under this section \$566,065 shall be deemed to
10 come from the funds available under section 216(a)(1) of the Compact
11 of Free Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
12 apportioned as follows:

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To establish lapsing dates for State public project appropriations, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the
2 authority of any allottee to obligate funds already appropriated by
3 the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia for State public
4 projects shall lapse as of September 30, 1996, unless an earlier date
5 is provided for in the respective appropriation act.

6 Section 2. The authority of any allottee to obligate funds
7 henceforth appropriated by the Congress of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia for State public projects shall lapse at the end of the
9 second fiscal year following the original fiscal year of
10 appropriation, unless an earlier time is provided for in the
11 respective appropriation act.

12 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
14 law without such approval.
