A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended, to apportion certain funds previously appropriated therein, by further amending section 3, as amended, to change and specify the allottees of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The funds appropriated under section 1 of this act shall be apportioned as follows:

17 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, is hereby
18 further amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
20 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance
21 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the
22 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds
23 appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 2 of this act
24 shall be the PWP Development Authority. The allottee of the
25 funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii),

1 (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the
2 Mayor of Fono. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
3 subsections (1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of section 2
4 of this act shall be the Mayor of Pis-Paneu. The allottee of
5 the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(viii),
6 (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi), and (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of this act
7 shall be the Mayor of Weno. The allottee of the funds
8 appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(ix), (1)(b)(xii),
9 (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv), (1)(b)(xv), (1)(b)(xvi), and
10 (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weno
11 Projects Coordinator. The allottee of the funds appropriated
12 under subsection (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall be the
13 Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the
14 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this
15 act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The
16 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(i),
17 (1)(e)(ii) and (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the
18 Executive Director of the Hall Development Authority. The
19 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(iv),
20 (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the
21 Weito Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
22 appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(vii), (1)(e)(viii),
23 (1)(e)(ix), (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi), (1)(e)(xii), and (1)(e)(xiii)
24 of section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development
25 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under

subsections (1)(f)(i), (1)(f)(ii), and (1)(f)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive Director of COCA. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(iv), (1)(f)(v), (1)(f)(vi) and (1)(f)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuafik. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Kapingamarangi. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)a) and (2)(a)(v)b) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)c), (2)(c), (2)(d), (2)(e) and (2)(f) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Community Action Agency. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(b)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(b)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Meninkeder-lapalap of Madolenihmw. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections ~~(2)(b)(i)~~ (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d), (4)(e),


(4)(f), (4)(g), (4)(h), (4)(i), (4)(j) and (4)(k) of section 2 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Malem Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Utwe Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
