

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79 and 8-116, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79 and 8-116, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
