To further amend Public Law No. 7-117, as amended by Public Law No. 7-136, by further amending section 6, as amended by Public Law No. 7-136, for the purpose of modifying the uses of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Section 6 of Public Law No. 7-117, as amended by
2	Public Law No. 7-136, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 6. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
4	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
5	Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
6	year ending September 30, 1993, for the purpose of
7	constructing and/or improving roads and power distribution
8	systems in the Kitti and Madolenihmw Municipalities in
9	Pohnpei State. The sum appropriated under this section
10	shall e apportioned as follows:
11	(1) <u>Madolenihmw</u> .
12	(a) Temwen circumferential road \$ 25,000
13	(b) Nansalohi roads 50,000
14	(c) Lohd Pah roads 50,000
15	(d) Metipw-Dolapwail power
16	distribution
17	(e) Senpehn roads 30,000
18	(f) Kepine road 25,000
19	(g) Section 1 of Madolenihmw road(s). 35,000
20	(h) Pohnakahk (Chinatown) power
21	distribution
22	(2) <u>Kitti</u> .
23	(a) Tomwara road and power
24	distribution

(b) Pehleng Powe road and power

1	distribution \$ 50,000
2	(c) Toamwoaroahlong roads 30,000
