

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Law No. 8-79, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Law No. 8-79, to modify the use of funds; by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Law No. 8-79, to change the allottee of certain funds; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75 is hereby further amended to read as

8       Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Law No. 8-79,  
9       is hereby further amended to read as follows:

10       "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,  
11       administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including,  
12       but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the  
13       funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be  
14       the PWP Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
15       under subsections (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv) of  
16       section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Fono. The allottee of the funds  
17       appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of  
18       section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Pis-Paneu. The allottee of the  
19       funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(viii), (1)(b)(x),  
20       (1)(b)(xi), and (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of  
21       Weno. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(ix),  
22       (1)(b)(xii), (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv), (1)(b)(xv), (1)(b)(xvi), and  
23       (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weno Projects  
24       Coordinator. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(c)  
25       of section 2 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development

1 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of  
 2 section 2 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority.  
 3 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(i),  
 4 (1)(e)(ii) and (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive  
 5 Director of the Hall Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
 6 appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(iv), (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of  
 7 section 2 of this act shall be the Weito Development Authority. The allottee of  
 8 the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(vii), (1)(e)(viii),  
 9 (1)(e)(ix), (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi), (1)(e)(xii), and (1)(e)(xiii) of  
 10 section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee  
 11 of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(i), (1)(f)(ii), and  
 12 (1)(f)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive Director of COCA.  
 13 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(iv),  
 14 (1)(f)(v), (1)(f)(vi) and (1)(f)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
 15 Governor of the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
 16 subsection (2)(a)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof of  
 17 Sapwuafik. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
 18 (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro.  
 19 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iii) of  
 20 section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Kapingamarangi. The  
 21 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iv) of section 2  
 22 of this act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds  
 23 appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)a and (2)(a)(v)b of section 2  
 24 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. ~~The allottee of the funds~~  
 25 ~~appropriated under subsections (2)(d)(v)(d), (2)(e), (2)(f), (2)(g) and~~

8                    The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(a) of section 2 of  
9                    this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of  
10                  the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of  
11                  this act shall be the Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of  
12                  the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of section 2 of  
13                  this act shall be the Mayor of the Malem Municipal Government. The allottee  
14                  of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this act  
15                  shall be the Mayor of the Utwe Municipal Government. The allottee of the  
16                  funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of section 2 of this act shall be  
17                  the Mayor of the Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottees shall be  
18                  responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
19                  necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no  
20                  obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of  
21                  the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

22                  Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated  
23                  States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
