### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-18, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-39, 8-44, 8-51, 8-73 and 8-77, by further amending sections 1, 3, 5 and 11, as amended by Public Law No. 8-39, and by further amending section 9, as amended by Public Law No. 8-44, to appropriate the sum of \$1,054,236 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, as supplemental funding for the operations of the executive branch, National judiciary, National Postal Service, other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds, and COM-FSM; to reprogram certain funds; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-18, as amended by 1 Public Law No. 8-39, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 2 "Section 1.
