## AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-87, Yap State public projects, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-18 and 6-71, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-18 and 6-71, to establish a lapse date for the authority to obligate funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 5-87, as amended by

2 Public Laws Nos. 6-18 and 6-71, is hereby further amended to read as

3 follows:

"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be the Governor of the State of Yap who shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1994."
