A RESOLUTION

Requesting that the Micronesian Maritime Authority immediately put into effect a moratorium on all foreign fishing activities in the Federated States of Micronesia and not renew any foreign fishing agreements, permits or licenses after their expiration.

- 1 WHEREAS, fish and other marine resources in the territorial waters
- 2 of the Federated States of Micronesia are potentially the most valuable
- 3 natural resources of the Nation and its greatest potential source of
- 4 revenue; and
- 5 WHEREAS, these valuable marine resources are subject to depletion
- 6 by overfishing and destruction by environmental factors; and
- 7 WHEREAS, these vulnerable marine resources must be protected and
- 8 husbanded for their maximum benefit to the Nation both now and for
- 9 future generations; and
- 10 WHEREAS, these marine resources are part of a complex and fragile
- 11 ecosystem particularly vulnerable to abuse and destruction by
- 12 improvident human activities such as illegal dumping of toxic,
- 13 hazardous and other waste materials; and
- 14 WHEREAS, certain foreign fishing activities are known to have
- 15 violated certain of the Federated States of Micronesia's fishing and
- 16 pollution control laws and regulations, therefore endangering these
- 17 valuable marine resources; and
- 18 WHEREAS, established by public record the licensing fees which
- 19 foreign fishermen now pay to the Federated States of Micronesia to fish
- 20 in the Nation's territorial waters are grossly lower than comparable
- 21 fees; and
- 22 WHEREAS, foreign fishermen do not now generally provision their
- 23 ships in the Federated States of Micronesia and thus deprive the Nation
- 24 of substantial revenues from that source; and
- 25 WHEREAS, foreign fishermen do not now generally refuel their ships

- 1 in the Federated States of Micronesia and thus deprive the Nation of
- 2 substantial revenues from that source; and
- 3 WHEREAS, foreign fishermen generally do not use Federated States of
- 4 Micronesia manpower for stevedoring their vessels, resulting in still
- 5 further financial losses to the Nation; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia as the
- 7 elected representative of the Federated States of Micronesia people must
- 8 convey to the executive branch the people's increasing concern that the
- 9 Nation's fish and other valuable marine resources are not being
- 10 adequately protected, husbanded or valued; now, therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighth Congress of the Federated States of
- 12 Micronesia, First Special Session, 1994, that the Micronesian Maritime
- 13 Authority immediately put into effect a moratorium on all foreign
- 14 fishing activities in the territorial waters of the Federated States
- 15 of Micronesia, where legal and practicable, and not renew any foreign
- 16 fishing permits, licenses or other agreements which may now be in
- 17 effect, following the expiration of such permits, licenses or other
- 18 agreements; and
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
- 20 transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia and
- 21 the Executive Director of the Micronesian Maritime Authority.
