A RESOLUTION

To ratify the "Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and Their Disposal."

- WHEREAS, the "Basel Convention on the Control of
- 2 Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and Their Disposal"
- 3 ("Basel Convention"), was adopted at the Conference of
- Plenipotentiaries on the Global Convention on Transboundary 4
- Movements of Hazardous Wastes, in Basel, Switzerland, on March 5
- 6 22, 1989; and
- WHEREAS, the Basel Convention was developed under the 7
- auspices of the United Nations Environment Programme, and 8
- 9 represents the intention of the international community to solve
- 10 the global environmental problem of controlling the movements and
- 11 disposal of hazardous wastes; and
- WHEREAS, 1994 estimates reveal that the generation of 12
- hazardous wastes globally amounts to almost 400 million tons per 13
- annum; and 14
- WHEREAS, a large amount of hazardous waste crosses national 15
- 16 frontiers, and a large volume of these movements is sent from
- industrialized countries to developing countries and to countries 17
- with economies in transition; and 18
- WHEREAS, the Basel Convention represents a first step in 19
- defining the global means to reduce and strictly control the 20
- 21 movements of hazardous wastes and to ensure that these wastes are
- 22 disposed of in an environmentally sound manner; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the Basel Convention provides realistic measures to
- 24 strengthen the protection of the global environment from the
- 25 possible harmful effects of the transboundary movements of

- 1 hazardous wastes and their disposal, and focuses on the
- 2 protection of human health and the environment; and
- WHEREAS, the Basel Convention includes the obligation to
- 4 reduce the generation of hazardous wastes to a minimum and to
- 5 ensure that the sovereign right of each state to ban the import
- 6 of hazardous wastes into its territory is observed; and
- WHEREAS, the Basel Convention prohibits the export and
- 8 import of hazardous wastes from and to non-parties to the
- 9 Convention unless such movement is subject to bilateral,
- 10 multilateral or regional agreements or arrangements whose
- 11 provisions are not less stringent than those of the Basel
- 12 Convention; and
- WHEREAS, the Basel Convention requests that hazardous wastes
- 14 be disposed of as close as possible to their source of generation
- 15 and that transboundary movement of hazardous wastes only be
- 16 allowed if carried out in accordance with the strict control
- 17 system provided by the Convention, including prior informed
- 18 consent by the importing country as well as the transit country;
- 19 and
- 20 WHEREAS, transboundary movements of hazardous wastes carried
- 21 out in contravention of the provisions of the Basel Convention
- 22 are to be considered illegal traffic and a criminal act; and
- WHEREAS, the Basel Convention calls for international
- 24 cooperation between parties in the environmentally sound
- 25 management of hazardous wastes and the improvement of national

1 capabilities to manage hazardous waste in an environmentally

- 2 sound manner; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Basel Convention also calls for the development
- 4 of a technical and legal infrastructure on a national level
- 5 including national legislation and regulations implementing the
- 6 Convention; and
- WHEREAS, for states which lack the resources for full
- 8 implementation of the Basel Convention, technical assistance may
- 9 be provided by the Secretariat of the Convention; and
- 10 WHEREAS, prevention of the potentially devastating
- 11 consequences of failure to effectively control the transboundary
- 12 movements of hazardous wastes and safely provide for their
- 13 disposal is of paramount importance to the Federated States of
- 14 Micronesia, as a small island developing country whose economy is
- 15 dependent upon protection of the environment; now, therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighth Congress of the Federated
- 17 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1994, that pursuant
- 18 to article IX, section 2(b) of the Constitution of the Federated
- 19 States of Micronesia, the Congress hereby ratifies the "Basel
- 20 Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous
- 21 Wastes and Their Disposal."; and
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon receipt of this resolution
- 23 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia the Secretary
- 24 of External Affairs shall lodge with the Secretary-General of the
- 25 United Nations as depository, an instrument of ratification; and
