## A RESOLUTION

Approving the Foreign Fishing Agreement between the Micronesian Maritime Authority and the Taiwan Deep Sea Tuna Boat Owners and Exporters Association.

1	WHEREAS, section 405 of title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia, as amended, requires the approval of Congress by resolution of any
3	and all foreign fishing agreements involving six or more vessels; and
4	WHEREAS, on September 30, 1994, the Micronesian Maritime Authority,
5	hereinafter referred to as the "Authority", made and entered into a foreign fishing
6	agreement with the Taiwan Deep Sea Tuna Boat owners and Exporters
7	Association, hereinafter referred to as the "Association", involving forty-four purse
8	seniors; and
9	WHEREAS, the fishing agreement between the Authority and the Association
10	if approved by Congress, will generate \$3,027,200 as revenues to be deposited in
11	the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia; and
12	WHEREAS, the agreement represents the highest financial return ever to the
13	Federated States of Micronesia from Taiwan; and
14	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Federated States of Micronesia to
15	approve the agreement; now, therefore,
16	BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighth Congress of the Federated States of
17	Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1994, that the Congress hereby approves the
18	Foreign Fishing Agreement between the Micronesian Maritime Authority and the
19	Taiwan Deep Sea Tuna Boat Owners and Exporters Association; and
