NINTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA SECOND REGULAR SESSION, 1995

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by further amending section 404, as amended by Public Law No. 6-11, for the purpose of requiring that all foreign fishing agreements include a provision prohibiting any commercial fishing within twenty-four miles of the territory of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 404 of title 24 of the Code of the Federated 2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 6-11, is hereby 3 further amended to read as follows: "Section 404. Foreign fishing agreements -- Terms. 4 5 All foreign fishing agreements shall have the following minimum terms: (1) The foreign party and the owner or operator of 7 8 any fishing vessel shall acknowledge the exclusive fishery management authority of the Federated States of Micronesia 9 within the Eexclusive Eeconomic Zzone; 10 11 (2) The foreign party or the owner or operator of any fishing vessel fishing, as appropriate, pursuant to such 12 13 agreement shall: (a) comply with the requirements of this title, 14 all regulations issued pursuant to this title and all other 15 applicable laws and regulations; 16 (b) permit any officer authorized to enforce the 17 18 provisions of this title to board and search or inspect any vessel at any time and make arrests and seizures provided 19 for in section 508 of this title whenever such officer has 20 reasonable cause to believe, as a result of such a search 21 or inspection, that any such vessel or any person has 22 23 committed an act prohibited by this title; (c) permit such officer to examine and make 24

negotiations on any permit issued pursuant to sections 109

1 through 111 of this title, or other documentation required 2 under any applicable foreign fishing agreement; 3 (d) allow and assist any authorized officer to enforce the provisions of this title, regulations made 4 thereunder and any other applicable laws or regulations; (e) immediately comply with every instruction given by an authorized officer, facilitate safe boarding, and facilitate the inspection of the vessel, gear, equipment, records, fish and fish products; 9 (f) allow and assist authorized observers to 10 11 board the vessel for scientific, monitoring, compliance and 12 other functions, and have full access to, and the use of, facilities and equipment on board the vessel which the 13 14 authorized observer may determine is necessary to carry out his duties; have full access to the bridge, fish on board 15 and areas which may be used to hold, process, weigh and 16 store fish; remove samples; have full access to the 17 vessel's records, including its logs and documentation for 18 the purpose of inspection and copying; and gather any other 19 information relating to fisheries in the Eexclusive 20 Eeconomic Zzone; 21 (g) not assault, obstruct, resist, delay, refuse 22 boarding to, intimidate, or interfere with an authorized 23 officer or authorized observer in the performance of his 24 duties; 25

1	(h) display any permit or permit number issued
2	for any such vessel pursuant to sections 109 through 111 of
3	this title or any documentation required to be displayed
4	under foreign fishing agreements in the wheelhouse of such
5	vessel;
6	(i) ensure that appropriate position-fixing and
7	identification equipment shall be installed and maintained
8	in working order on each such vessel;
9	(j) ensure that the vessel is marked in
10	accordance with regulations issued by the Authority while
11	within the \underline{E} exclusive \underline{E} economic \underline{Z} eone;
12	(k) require that the National Government of the
13	Federated States of Micronesia shall be reimbursed for the
14	cost of authorized observers;
15	(1) appoint and maintain an agent within the
16	Federated States of Micronesia who is authorized to receive
17	and respond to any legal process issued in the Federated
18	States of Micronesia with respect to such owner or operator
19	of such vessel; And
20	(m) not, in any year, exceed such party's
21	allocation of the total allowable level of foreign fishing,
22	in the event allocations are established in accordance with
23	this title; and
24	(n) agree to refrain from, and refrain from, any
25	commercial fishing within twelve (12) miles of the

1	outermost limits of the territorial waters of the Federated
2	States of Micronesia, such that the waters within twenty-
3	four (24) miles of any territory of the Federated States of
4	Micronesia shall be deemed an area closed to fishing
5	according to the terms of any foreign fishing agreement
6	entered into under the provisions of this chapter.
7	(3) Foreign parties will:
8	(a) apply, pursuant to section 109 of this
9	title, for any required permits;
10	(b) deliver promptly to the owner or operator of
11	the appropriate fishing vessel any permit which is issued
12	under that section for such vessel; and
13	(c) abide by the requirement that no foreign
14	fishing will be permitted in the $\underline{\mathtt{E}} \bullet \mathtt{xclusive}$ $\underline{\mathtt{E}} \bullet \mathtt{conomic}$ $\underline{\mathtt{Z}} \bullet \mathtt{zone}$
15	without a valid and applicable permit, except as provided
16	by foreign fishing agreements concluded pursuant to this
17	chapter, and that all conditions and restrictions of the
18	permit, or any applicable foreign fishing agreement, are
19	complied with."
